

# The Easter Triduum 2018

Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil make up the Easter Triduum, a single celebration of the Paschal Mystery spread over three days, the center and high point of which is the Easter Vigil. The liturgies of the Easter Triduum — the evening Mass of the Lord’s Supper on Holy Thursday, the Good Friday Celebration of the Lord’s Passion and the Easter Vigil — “tell the story” that stands at the core of the Christian faith. They celebrate with grandeur the abiding significance of these sacred events in the lives of people today.

To help people understand and participate in these liturgies, the monastic community provides a series of lessons explaining the rites and meanings of each Triduum liturgy. These classes, held at the Morcone Center, and the liturgies occur as follows:
