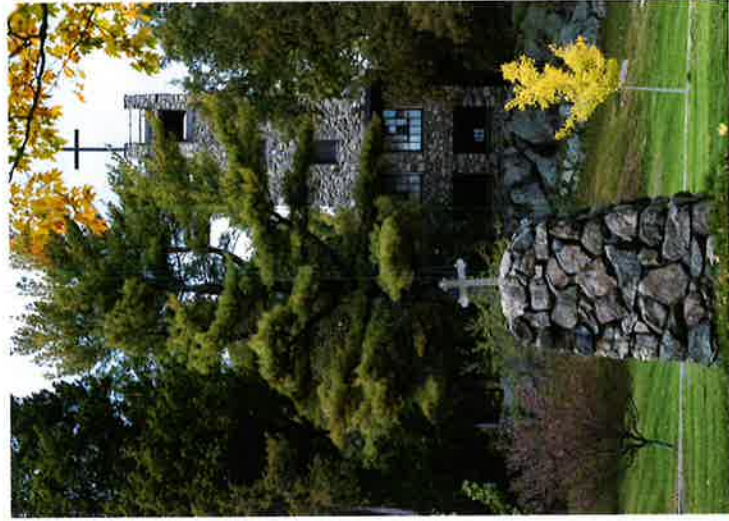

A Place of Sanctuary

The mission of Glastonbury Abbey is to be a Benedictine presence for the Church and to the people of the greater Boston area of New England.

The Columbarium at Glastonbury Abbey (CGA) offers the opportunity for burial after cremation on these beautiful and peaceful grounds. The private columbaria are designed as low, natural stone walls. A niche may be purchased for cremated remains which would be interred in the columbarium.

The CGA oversees the memorializing, placement and perpetual care of the cremated remains.

Each niche is a discrete chamber designed, constructed and intended for use as a permanent repository for the entombment of human cremated remains.

All cremation or funeral arrangements are to be made and completed by the family prior to cremains being interred at the CGA. The CGA will work with the family to schedule a time for interment to open and close the niche. Access will be dependent on weather and may be limited or closed during the winter months. The family is responsible for arranging any accompanying service and for bringing the cremains to the entombment.

Up to four cremains, each in a suitable container, are permitted. All four containers must fit within the 24"x14"x13" niche. The cost for engraving is the responsibility of the family. No other ornamentation is permitted on top of or around the columbarium. Only the following may be engraved:

Full Name
Date of Birth
Date of Death

A Niche Purchase Agreement enables up to 4 related or unrelated persons to sign. The Purchase Agreement, Deed, and CGA Policies and Definitions are available by contacting the CGA at 781-749-2155, Ext.371. A right-of-way clause is included in the Deed to ensure continuing access to the columbaria located next to the existing cemetery.

The cost of each niche is \$3000. There will be an additional cost of \$500 to the CGA: \$200 to defray the cost of perpetual care; \$300 each time the niche is opened and closed.

Entombment shall be permitted in assigned niche only after receipt of full payment.
